The following guide helps improve safety, ensure a secure and stable assembly of the stage deck. Always inspect connections and stability before use.

Safety Instructions

WARNING

- **Observe Load Capacity:** Do not exceed the recommended load limits to prevent structural collapse.
- **Inspect Components:** Ensure all components are undamaged before use. Bent, broken, or cracked parts compromise safety and should be replaced immediately.
- **Authorized Parts Only:** Only use parts supplied by Event Lighting. Unauthorized substitutes may not fit properly or may fail under stress.
- **Avoid Modifications:** Never bend, cut, or alter the unit's structure. Modifications weaken the riser and increase the risk of collapse.
- Safety Accessories: Determine whether additional safety features, such as handrails, are necessary for your specific setup
- Secure measures: Always ensure that all casters are securely locked before folding or unfolding the unit.
- **Be cautious of moving parts:** The unit contains moving parts that can pose a risk of harm or damage. Ensure that hands, fingers, or other objects are not in the path of these moving parts during operation.

Product Setup Instructions

1. Unfolding the unit:

1.1. Position the Unit:

- While the product is in its folded upright position, unlock the casters and carefully move the unit to the desired installation location.
- Ensure the surface is flat and level to maintain stability.

1.2. Lock the Casters:

 Once the unit is positioned, lock all casters to prevent unintended movement during setup.

1.3. Release the Frame:

• Remove the two security clips from the pins, and then remove the pins holding the frame in the upright position. (Refer to Picture 1 for details.)

1.4. Unfold the Frame:

- Slowly pull down the top of the frame.
- Continue to lower it gently until all legs are firmly on the ground.

2. Folding the Unit

2.1. Lift the Frame:


 Gradually lift the frame until it returns to the upright folded position.

2.2. Secure the Frame:

- Insert the two pins into the designated slots on the frame to lock it securely in place.
- Insert the security clips into both pins to ensure proper locking. (Refer to Picture 2 for details.)

2.3. Unlock the Casters:

Release the caster locks and carefully move the unit to its storage location.
