The following guide will help ensure the safe handling and longevity of the road cases while minimizing the risk of injury or equipment damage:

Safety Instructions

1. Pre-Use Inspection

- Check the Condition: Before using the road case, inspect it for any visible damage to locks, hinges, handles, or casters.
- Test Locks and Hinges: Ensure all locks, hinges, and latches operate smoothly. If any component is loose or malfunctioning, do not use the case; contact Eventec for repair.

2. Safe Locking and Latching

- Close Carefully: When closing the case, ensure nothing obstructs the edges, as this could damage the contents or lock mechanism.
- Secure Padlocks Properly: If the case is pad-lockable, use a padlock that fits securely. Check that each latch is securely fastened and locked before transporting to prevent accidental openings.
- Avoid Over-Tightening: Do not force locks, as over-tightening can damage the locking mechanism and make
 future locking difficult.

3. Safe Lifting and Handling

- **Use Proper Lifting Techniques**: Road cases are often heavy and require lifting with correct posture to prevent strain. Bend at the knees, keep the load close, and lift with your legs, not your back.
- Team Lifting for Heavier Cases: If the case is too heavy or large, get assistance from a colleague or use
 mechanical lifting equipment like a hand truck.
- Use Recessed Handles: Always lift from the recessed spring-return handles to ensure a firm grip and to avoid contact with sharp or protruding surfaces.

4. Moving the Case

- Check Casters: Before moving, ensure all casters (wheels) are working properly. If a caster is damaged or doesn't roll smoothly, stop using the case and arrange for repairs.
- Lock the Brakes: Engage the brakes on the casters when loading or unloading equipment from the case, especially if on an incline, to prevent movement.
- Use Smooth, Steady Movements: When rolling the case, avoid sudden stops or turns, which can destabilize the load or put strain on the caster mounts.

5. Stacking and Storage

- Stack with Caution: Only stack road cases if they are specifically designed for it. Use cases with interlocking features for safe, stable stacking.
- Avoid Overloading: Do not exceed the weight capacity or stack height recommendation to prevent instability or tipping.
- Store on a Flat Surface: Place road cases on a stable, flat surface when storing to avoid accidental movement and damage to contents.

6. Post-Use Inspection and Maintenance

- Clean After Use: Wipe down the exterior, especially the black textured laminate finish, to remove any dirt or debris. This will keep the surface clean and extend its lifespan.
- **Inspect for Damage**: After each use, inspect the locks, latches, and hinges to ensure they are functioning properly.
- **Report Issues Immediately**: If any component, including locks, hinges, or casters, is not working as expected, stop using the road case and contact Eventec to prevent accidents.

7. General Safety Tips

- **Keep Hands Clear of Hinges**: When opening or closing, keep hands and fingers clear of hinges and latches to avoid pinching injuries.
- Wear Gloves: If handling cases with rough surfaces or in cold weather, use gloves to improve grip and prevent cuts or abrasions.
