Dual speaker adjustable mount bracket SB600

For safety, please read this user manual carefully before initial use.

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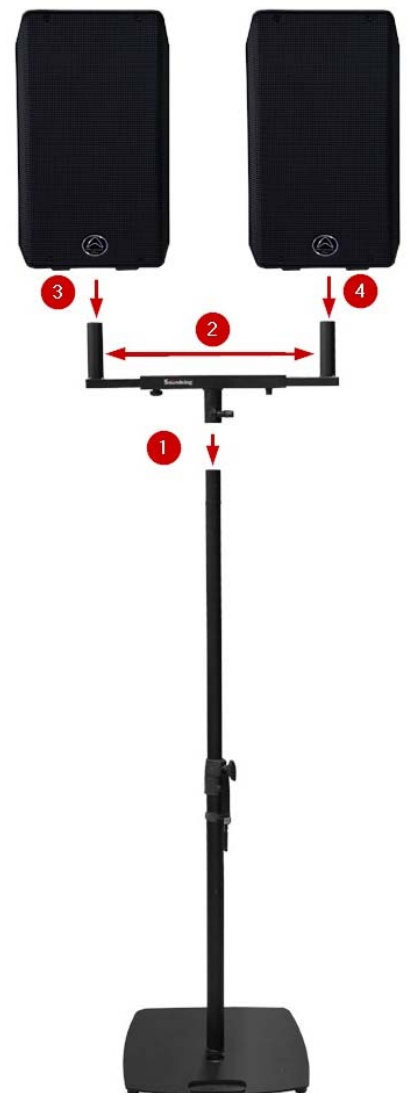
Safety Instructions

WARNING!

- **Max weight capacity:** 25 kg **per side** (50 kg total).
- **Balance the load:** Speakers on each mount must be of equal weight.
- **Use a second person:** Always have someone stabilize the stand while mounting speakers to prevent tipping.
- **Stand compatibility:** Ensure your speaker stand can support at least **50 kg**.
- **Inspect before use:** Check the bracket and stand for damage. Do **not** use if any part is damaged—replace immediately.

Assembly Guide

1. **Attach the bracket** to a **35mm pole speaker stand**. Tighten the **clamping insert** with the locking knob securely.
2. **Adjust the wings** to your desired width (360–510 mm) and lock each wing with its knob.
3. **Mount the first speaker** while a second person stabilizes the stand.
4. **Mount the second speaker** (equal weight) while the stand is still supported.
5. **For extra stability**, add sandbags or weights to the stand's base.
